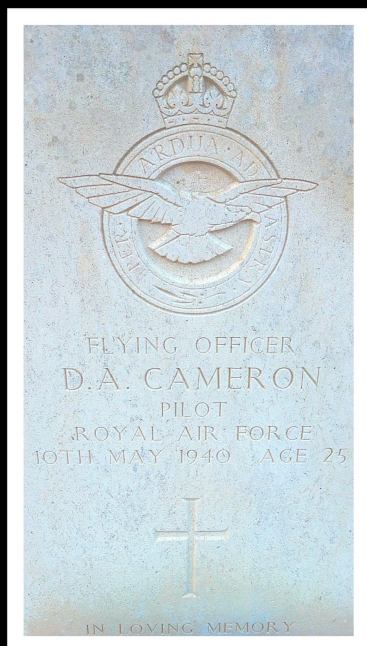




# SVQ 105

## 16,500 kilometers

... the Fairey Battle was a British bomber-fighter that performed poorly and was very vulnerable: It was slow, insufficiently armed and lacking an armoured cockpit. And yet, on the orders of Air Chief Marshal Sir Arthur Sheridan BARRATT (1891, +1966), thirty-two Fairey Battles of the Royal Air Force took part in an air raid launched on 10 May 1940 from the Reims air base against the German invaders who were advancing in occupied territories. FO (Flying Officer) Douglas Alexander CAMERON's Fairey Battle was seriously hit by FLAK (Flugabwehrkanone, German anti-aircraft defence) in the vicinity of Wallendorf and had to crash-land near Hierzenhaff on the heights south of Bettendorf. Sergeant C. S. HART and AC1 (Aircraftman 1st class) J. G. WARD managed to extricate themselves from the burning aircraft with a few scratches and bruises. The pilot was less fortunate: severely injured in the right arm, he died the same day at around 11 p.m. at the Clinique du Sacré-Cœur in Diekirch, where Dr Georges TANDEL (\*1910, +1968) had taken charge of him. There are now 16,500 km between Diekirch, the final resting place of Douglas Alexander CAMERON (\*1915, +1940) and his native Australia. Since the end of the war, Valérie WINTER-GEORGES (\*1911, +2006), then John 'Boy' NEVEN (\*1949, +2006) and finally the staff of the Musée National d'Histoire Militaire (MNHM), under the leadership of curator Roland GAUL, have devoted themselves to maintaining and flowering the grave of FO Doug A. CAMERON at Diekirch cemetery. (bp, fg, rg, bn, 2014-10-13)
